-Bryozoan does not appear in the Cambrian

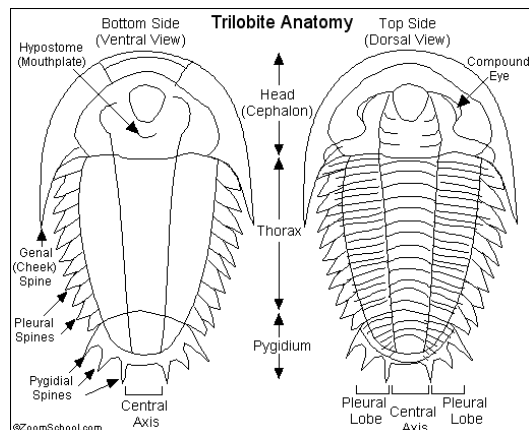
-Echinoderms are organisms with five fold symmetry a modern example is starfish.
