



## **Power Plus Scholarship Agreement**

Power Plus Scholarship is funded by Case Corp. and Western Power & Equipment. The corporate office is located at 4601 N.E. 77th Ave., Suite 200, Vancouver, WA with branches located all over the Western United States.

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

The applicant must be a Senior in high school, a recent high school graduate or have received his or her GED. The applicant must have a grade point of at least 2.5 for the year immediately prior to application, or for his or hers last completed year of school.

### Size and Duration of Scholarships

Western Power & Equipment, CASE Corp. and Portland Community College are taking an active role in insuring that future technicians are available. Western Power also offers a scholar-ship for community college students. To qualify for the Power Plus Scholarship, a student must be enrolled in the Diesel Technology Program at Portland Community College. They must have at least a 2.5 grade point average and be a candidate for an Associate in Applied Science Degree.

This scholarship covers the cost of tuition and 50% of the cost of textbooks. Along with the cash award, the scholarship provides the student with employment, as a technical trainee for twenty hours a week during the school year and 40 hours a week during the summer months. The student will receive regular trainee wages and will be considered a temporary employee.

### Student's Responsibility

In order to comply with IRS regulations, the Company requires receipts verifying the recipients use of scholarship funds. In addition, each scholar must report the courses taken and grades received by providing the Company with an Official Transcript at the end of each term.
