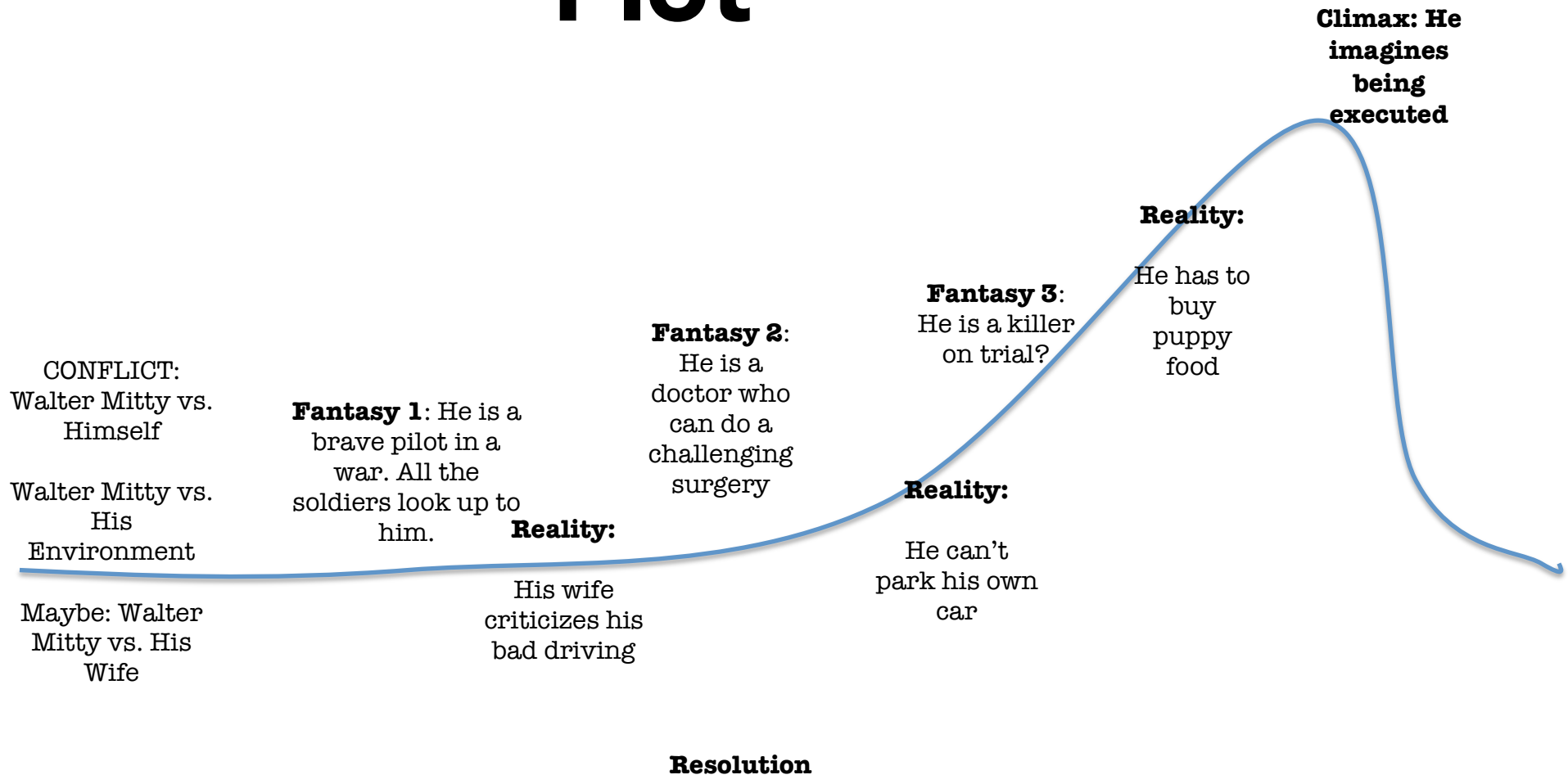


Plot
