Important Keys

A rounded rectangular button with the text "2nd" inside.

second key

A rounded rectangular button with the text "ALPHA" inside.

alpha key

diamond key

backspace key

Concepts

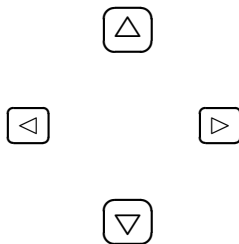
Homescreen – mainscreen where math is performed.

Cursor – blinking box.

Menu – pops up to allow more operations.

Window – the calculator screen when graphing. The window determines what the graph will look like.
