To run an already existing program :

From the home screen, go into the var-link menu by pressing 2nd —, put the cursor on the program name and press **ENTER**. This will bring the program's name to your home screen. You must place a "closing" parenthesis at the end of your program's name, e.g.

ration()

mth 93

Pressing **ENTER** will run the program.

<u>To edit an existing program</u> :

Go into the Program Editor, possibly \fbox{PPS} 7 2 . Choose the program and press \fbox{ENTER} . Make any changes and then press $\fbox{2nd}$ \fbox{ESC} , which saves the program.

<u>Note</u>: Be Careful that you don't make any changes that you do not want. After your write over a line and exit, the change is made for good.

To enter a NEW program :

Go into the Program Editor, possibly **APPS 7 3** and enter the program's name.

Type in the code.

Pressing $\boxed{2nd}$ \boxed{ESC} saves the program.

To transfer programs from calculator to calculator :
