

-Continental Crust is made of feldsparic rocks (sedimentary, igneous and metamorphic)

-Igneous rocks form by the volcanic process. An example of an igneous rock is granite.

-Metamorphic rocks form when heat, pressure, or chemical reactions in the Earth's interior change the mineralogy, chemical composition and structure of any type of preexisting rock. An example of a metamorphic rock is gneiss.
