

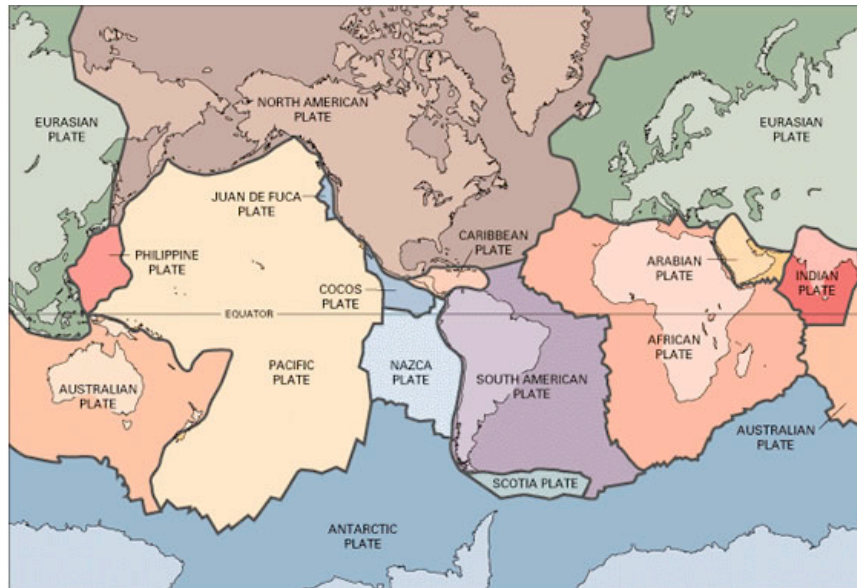
Aesthenosphere- AKA “the squishy layer”; like warm butter is a solid but can become liquid (magma) easily.

Mesosphere- is in the Earth’s mantle between the aesthenosphere and the outer core.

Outer Core- consists of super-hot liquid lava, which is made up of mostly iron and nickel.

Inner Core- is a solid ball of mostly iron and nickel.

PLATE TECTONICS
